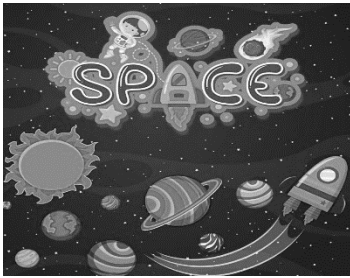


Albrighton & District Civic Society

Albrighton and District Civic Society supports the Albrighton Fayre Committee and our representative, Rod Smith, has arranged the Air Ambulance Charity to bring the Helipod and to lead the parade with a fly-past. This year's Fayre is going to be held on Sat 13th July from 10am and this year the theme is "Space".

FixMyStreet is primarily for reporting things which are broken, dirty, damaged or dumped, and need fixing, cleaning or clearing, like graffiti, dog fouling, potholes or street lights that don't work, broken drains, water leaking on to the road or even tree roots damaging pavement.

Potholes on Newport Road into the village just before Grange Park to the war memorial are particularly bad and dangerous, but have you reported them? Don't think someone else will report it. Your report might be the one that makes the council do something. Use FixMyStreet app and online, and when they say the work is completed, check, if it is not. Re-report. Don't give up. Send pictures using the app or online.
